



To Setup an email account with Outlook 2003-2007

Follow the steps below:

1. Open Outlook. On the top menu click **Tools** and **Account Settings**...



2. On the E-mail tab, click **New**.







3. Select **"Manually configure server settings or additional server types"** and click Next >.

- 6. Click [More Settings] button located in the bottom right corner.
- 7. Click the **Outgoing Server** tab. Make sure that 'My outgoing server (SMTP) requires authentication' is selected.







8. Click on the **Advanced tab**.

This server requires an encrypted connection (SSL) = **Not Selected**. Change the Outgoing server (SMTP) number to **25**. Use the following type of encrypted connection = **None**.
